DAILY RIDE 7:00-11:00 AM

Riders choice of gravel or paved road with distances ranging up to 50 miles or longer. These rides go through a variety of small Nebraska towns full of charm revealing true Nebraska character.

Two or more guides will accompany each ride, one as the leader and the other as a sweep to assist with breakdowns or other issues. A vehicle will be available to pick up riders should they not wish to complete the ride.

LUNCH 12:00-1:00 PM

Lunch with a vegetarian option will be provided at the Crane Trust headquarters. If you have other dietary issues please feel free to bring along whatever you need.

EXPLORE 1:00-5:00 PM

In the afternoon the campers are free to explore the prairie on fat bikes which will be available to check out. There are miles of jeep and mowed grass trails to explore many within view of the Crane Trust bison herd. Our coach and sponsors will also be offering coaching and cycling related workshops that are available to all campers.

You may also want to leave our campus and visit local wineries or go antique shopping in local towns but be sure not to miss the ground up building of a new Specialized S-Works Diverge that will be auctioned off to one lucky camper!

Dinner will include locally catered meals or cookouts with Nebraska beef, chicken, and even bison. As always, a vegetarian option will be provided. Soft drinks and beer are provided each evening.

About the Crane Trust's WILD ROSE RANCH

The Wild Rose Ranch is nestled inside the Crane Trust's 6,000 acres of historic prairie in South Central Nebraska. Camp guests will ride on Mormon Island where Brigham Young slept while taking his followers to Utah. Nearly all of this 2,000 acre island has never been tilled and remains the largest piece of original tall and mixed grass prairie left on the Platte River. Guests will ride where actual wagon ruts were made by covered wagons as they followed the Platte River on the Oregon Trail looking for gold or just a new life in the west. They'll stand where the young Martin Brothers were chased by Native Americans and eventually pinned together by an arrow while on horse-back.
